FAMOUS TRIALS

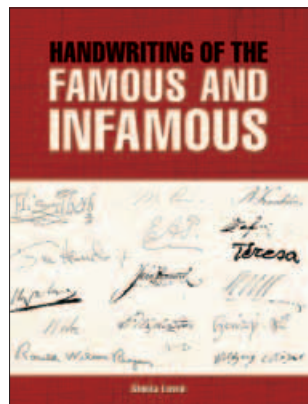
